KIBBER- TSOMORIRI LAKE (Over Parangla Pass 5700 Mts) *****

The name Spiti (Tibetan: Spiti) means "middle land": the land between India & Tibet. Extreme weather conditions have kept the breathtakingly beautiful twin paradise of Kinnaur Spiti in Himachal Pradesh out of common tourist itinerary for ages, preserving its cultural innocence and pristine terrain. Ladakh is called "Little Tibet" and provides the perfect setting for challenge and discovery in a wild lunar landscape. This specially designed hiking and trekking tour from Spiti to Ladakh in Himalayas is a combined effort of a team of certified mountaineers and travel agents in India aiming at making travel economical and affordably cheap for the budget trekker walking in Ladakh as well as maintaining quality at par with the world-class standards. We feel our job as tour operators and trek guides, is to design treks giving our customers a memorable experience in trekking adventure.

New Delhi - Chandigarh - Manali - Spiti - Kibber - Shingo La - Parang Glacier - Tarang Yogma - Tso Moriri - Karzok - Rajung Karu - Tso Kar - Leh - New Delhi

Grade: Moderate

Time: June to October

Duration: 26 days

Average Walking time: 5-6 hours per day

Day 01: Arrival New Delhi

Assistance upon arrival and transfer to your hotel. Afternoon at Leisure. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 02: New Delhi- Manali (560 Kms- 12 hrs)

After breakfast half day city tour of New Delhi visiting Presidents house, India Gate, Parliament house & For lunch we drop down to Connaught Place (Centre of New Delhi). Catch evening Bus to Manali.

Day 03: Manali

Early morning arrival at Manali, Assistance upon arrival and transfer to your hotel. Afternoon in relaxing and a short walk to Hadimba Temple in evening. Overnight at hotel.

Day 04: Manali

After breakfast half day excursion tour visiting Naggar, a small village located on the left bank of river Beas. Naggar was once the capital of Kullu princely state. It has a Castle which is now converted into a heritage hotel. Evening drive back to Manali. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 05: Manali- Kaza (200 Kms/ 08 hrs)

We start early for Kaza. It is 200 Kms from Manali but the roads are very narrow & dusty making the travel more hectic. We cross Rohtang Pass (3980 Mts) which is lifeline road to the people of Lahaul & Spiti and after crossing Rohtang Pass we follow the Chandra River until Kunzum Pass (4551 Mts). Evening arrival at Kaza and check in hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 06: Kaza- Local Sightseeing

After Breakfast we move for a half day excursion tour visiting some of the Highest & Oldest Monasteries of the Valley i.e. Langza & Comic Monastery. By lunch we drive back to our hotel. Evening at Leisure. Overnight at hotel.

Day 07: Kaza-Dumla

22kms/4hrs, Drive Kaza - Kibber (18kms).

Kibber village at 4205m is one of the highest inhabited settlements in India. The famous Ki gompa is just 10 kms away and can be visited before beginning the trek. Kibber to Dumla is an easy walk but take your time, as these Spitian gorges are renowned for being hard-going. Overnight tents.

Day 08: Dumla-Thaltak Meadow

7kms/5hrs/4875m/16000ft.

Descend to the gorge bed and start the climb towards the pass, a steep walk to Thaltak Meadow where you camp for the night. The scenery is wild and the gorge is deep. Even at this height the sunlight reflected from the walls of the gorge causes the temperature to soar. Overnight in tents.

Day 09: Thaltak-Jagtha-Bonrojen

14kms/7hrs/5180m/17000ft.

This is a long and strenuous day walking to Jagtha - 8kms at 15,700 ft. and then 6kms to Bongrojen at 17,000ft.. Make sure to acclimatize well in the previous 2 days. Overnight in Tents.

Day 10: Bongrojen-Dak Karzong

10 kms/5hrs/4940m/16200 ft.

Leave early for the pass. The final 4 kms is a steep 2-hour climb to Parang La at 18,300 ft.. The pass lies on the trade route between Ladakh and the Spiti valley. There are some great views of the Spiti and the Changthang valleys from the pass. Parilungi, a conical peak, is the first Ladakhi peak visible from Spiti. From the pass, we descend to the source of the Pare Chu River. After the pass, the landscape changes dramatically from steep gorges to broad plains. Camp at Dak Karzong

Day 11: Dak Karzong-Datang Yongma

12kms/5hrs/4725m/15500 ft.

The route for the next 3 days is in a fairly open valley with a well-marked trail on the left bank of the Pare Chu. Camp overnight at Datang Yongma.

Day 12: Datang Yongma-Chumik Shilde

16kms/5-6 hrs

The next day, follow the trail to Racholemo (14000 ft.) then Norbu Sumdo (14400 ft.) and across to Chumik Shilde. Start early as the winds can be strong in the afternoons. Overnight in Tents.

Day 13: Chumik Shilde-Tso Moriri

14kms/5hrs/4510m/14800 ft.

Today we walk across the plains to the southern edge of the oval-shaped Tso Moriri at Kingdom, named after the kiangs (wild Tibetan asses) which roam here freely. The lake breaks into several channels here to create a vast wetland, the

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breeding ground of several rare species of birds. Overnight in Tents.

Day 14: Tso Moriri–Karzog 15 kms/6-7hrs/4527m/14850 ft.

The last day of the trek passes along the shore of Tso Moriri. The view of the lake with Lungser Kangri (6666m/ 21,871ft.) in the background is unforgettable. The walk is longer than it looks and with the afternoon winds you will be tired when you reach Karzog. Visit the ancient monastery in Karzog, where the Changpas roam the pastures with their flocks of Pashmina goats and still live in yak-skin yurts. Overnight in Tents.

Day 15: Karzog–Leh (213 kms) Drive to Leh

via Mahe Bridge. Drive to Leh crossing some of the beautiful high altitude villages. By evening we arrive in Leh. Check in your hotel and we get together for the night during our dinner. Overnight in Leh.

Day 16: Leh- Local City Tour

After breakfast we make a half day sightseeing excursion visiting Shey Palace, Thiksey Monastery and Hemis Monastery. For lunch we drive back to Leh. Evening at leisure. Overnight at hotel.

Day 17: Leh- Alchi & Likir Monastery

After breakfast we make a full day sightseeing excursion visiting Alchi Monastery & Likir Monastery. Today we will have Pack lunches with us. By evening we drive back to Leh. Overnight at hotel in Leh.

Day 18: Leh- New Delhi

An Early morning transfer to Domestic Airport to board flight to New Delhi. Assistance upon arrival at New Delhi. Transfer to your hotel and overnight at hotel in New Delhi.

Day 19: Reserve Day (in case of flight Cancellation)

We keep one day reserve for the Flight, as during Monsoon sometimes flights to & from Leh are cancelled and if the flight is not cancelled than this reserve day will be for a Full day sightseeing tour to New Delhi-Agra-New Delhi

Day 20: New Delhi Departure

In time transfer to International Airport to board flight back home.
